

#### **Education**

We support Safety Education in the Digital Age

On International Safer Internet Day, we joined forces with important local partners and offered people support in increasing online safety.

For 2 hours, we were present in Iulius Mall Suceava, where we held useful discussions with adults and children. In addition to the information shared, we provided support materials suitable for all age groups.



We have equipped Suceava Elementary School no. 3's computer lab with robotics equipment.

We are delighted to have made this investment in educating young people, and we express our gratitude to everyone who contributed to this noble cause. Now, the students of Secondary School No. 3 can unleash their imaginations and create diverse and exceptional robots.

From the total investment of €1,835, we purchased hardware equipment and robotics building elements.

The community of Suceava responded quickly to the fundraising campaign.

As a result, on April 6th, we had the pleasure of equipping the computer lab of **Secondary School No. 3** with cutting-edge robotics equipment.













#### We modernized a SMART classroom at the "Nicu Gane" Fălticeni National College



Thanks to the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation, students at "Nicu Gane" National College, in Falticeni, now have access to a modern SMART classroom equipped with state-of-the-art technology. This initiative came after an appeal made by the teachers to modernize the classroom, and our volunteers and donors responded promptly and generously.

The classroom has been creatively renovated and decorated, and the technological equipment donated by ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation will make a difference in the students' learning process. The donation provided was worth a total of €2,100 and consisted of high-quality devices:

- Audio system
   Two TVs
- Laptop
   Printer
- Graphics tablet
   Video projector

By using this modern equipment, teachers can provide **engaging and practical lessons**, and students can learn **interactively and interestingly**.

ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation aims to support the development of youth and education in the Suceava community. This project provides a beneficial solution to the locals.





In April, students who completed the "Safety Education in the Digital Age" course received their certification.
Volunteers were educated on online risks and prevention of cybercrime.

The project will continue with information sessions in high schools and general schools as this educational program is carried out in partnership with:



The **AutoVortex** team, which also includes Adrian Hânţescu from Suceava, won a medal in South Korea and won first prize at the International Robotics Championship in India.

Adrian and the AutoVortex team successfully represented our country at the World Robotics Championship in Houston, Texas, United States of America. The Romanian team was noticed this time as well, returning home with the titles of "Finalist Alliance Award" and "Control Award".

In order to be able to travel to this large-scale competition, the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation sponsored Adrian with the amount of €2,500.





We organized creative workshops during the Summer School -"Childhood, a world of dreams"

In August, <u>Secondary School No. 1</u>
<u>Suceava</u> organized the 4th edition of the Summer School "**Childhood**, a world of dreams". During these fruitful days, around **60 students** eager for adventure explored their creativity.

The support of the ASSIST

€2,400 reduced the participation
fee to €30 for each child and
opened doors to a memorable
experience.



#### We held a cyber security workshop as part of the "La Marginea Şcolii" camp

The True Health organization from Suceava organized the "La Marginea Şcolii" Summer Camp, an adventurous learning experience for young people between the ages of 14 and 24. Participants explored various topics, including health, personal development, effective communication, IT, programming and neuroscience, with entrepreneurs, teachers and specialists.

The week ended with an outdoor movie show under the starry sky, leaving their hearts full of joy and precious memories.

"La Marginea Şcolii" meant more than technical progress; it symbolized a significant step towards rural development through collaboration and partnership. Participants connected with like-minded peers, explored various topics, gained confidence and ignited sparks of innovation.







# We supported a young woman from Suceava to study at an international university

Karla is currently doing a Computing Science BSc degree at the University of Glasgow, where the annual tuition fee is £9250 plus a £5400 accommodation fee.

To cover these expenses, the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation contributed €2,000.

#### We donated over 100 schoolbags with supplies to students from underprivileged rural communities

On September 1st, the ASSIST

EUROACTIV Association, the EduMax
Association and the FARA Foundation in
the "Bring the Children to School"
campaign.

More than **100 schoolbags** equipped with school materials and sweets reached children from disadvantaged backgrounds in Preutești and Basarabi, emphasizing the importance of education and integrating these young people into the school system.

During the event, police officers talked to students and parents about the **importance of education** in developing young people and promoted crucial messages to **eliminate discrimination.** 



By participating in this project, these children have received educational resources and confidence in their potential.

#### We celebrated Children's Day at the Children's Festival

This year, children from our community were invited to **EduFortress 2023** – Festival of Childhood, an event dedicated to celebrating them and childhood. The EduMax Center for Personal and Professional Development hosted a festival at <u>Suceava's Citadel</u> – a location steeped in **history and stories of brave heroes.** 

The most **adventurous** tested their courage and skill with VR glasses.
Virtual reality allowed them to take on the persona of their favourite character and **experience their** superpowers firsthand.

Visitors at the **ASSIST Humanitarian**Foundation booth were greeted with colourful balloons, sweets, and smiles. At the face painting workshop, volunteers prepared a variety of superhero designs for children to choose from.



To preserve the memory of this day, we set up a photo corner where children could take pictures next to a panel featuring the most popular superheroes and various themed props.

#### We helped the Easter Bunny to bring gifts to the children of FARA Foundation in Falticeni



The Easter Bunny sent our volunteers with gifts to the children of FARA Foundation. The little ones welcomed us with open arms and were excited to spend time with us. It was an experience full of colour and smiles!

In addition, two cases of children in need of humanitarian aid were presented, and through this event organized by In Business, the necessary assistance will be given to these children.

Suceava Association, in partnership with the Municipal Theatre "Matei


Viṣniec" Suceava and the Art College

On May 6th, 30 children from Baineţ had an adventurous and fun day thanks to the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation and **Hope 4 Humanity Association**.The organizations took the kids to the Bucovina Village Museum where they participated in many entertaining activities.

Guided by a museum staff, the children had the opportunity to discover the fascinating story of traditional houses and they were encouraged to discover their own cultural identity.



#### We provided educational support to children from disadvantaged backgrounds

In collaboration with the <u>EUROACTIV</u>
Association, we organized a special initiative aimed at helping children from less privileged backgrounds in our county. These young people joined the "**Build the Future Together**" project within the Summer School. An EduMax representative assisted the children in workshops, focusing on future skills.

Moreover, at the end of the summer school, the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation surprised **50 children** with fully equipped school bags for their educational journey.







The session started with a get-to-know-you activity, followed by a teambuilding exercise. Concepts such as competence, ability, aptitude, and knowledge were discussed.

Afterwards, participants engaged in group exercises focused on key competencies for future professions. This allowed them to **explore** how they could adapt to the demands of the labour market. The session ended with a **self-reflection exercise** where the children explored the competences they aspire to acquire.

## We helped schools become more friendly and welcoming



At **Baineţ Secondary School**, the only one in the village of Museniţa, school dropout has proven to be a serious problem over time. Despite the teachers' best efforts, children easily drop out in favour of work.

In order to support the development of the local community through education, the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation, along with other organizations and community members from Suceava, organized a campaign called "Well-being in School." This project involved setting up a relaxation and reading corner and beautifying the interior walls of Bainet, Secondary School, which has around 80 students enrolled. The work was carried out from January to March 2023.





#### **Culture**

We supported the 10th edition of the "Autumn Symphonies" cultural event

ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation was the main partner of the "Autumn Symphonies" cultural event organized by Rotary Club Suceava-Bucovina.

Over 10,000 spectators attended the concert and enjoyed an impressive musical experience with numerous special moments. Renowned artists such as countertenor Cezar Ouatu, soprano Maria Miron-Sîrbu, soprano Mădălina Stan, pianist Liana Maureș and baritone Iordache Basalic took the stage.

A premiere for Suceava County was the **drone show** offered by the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation. Various shapes were depicted in the sky of the city, which highlighted the musical notes.





#### We supported the Matei Vişniec International Theater Days Festival



In May, Suceava has become a true cultural centre, hosting the prestigious International Festival "Days of the Matei Vişniec Theatre". This event brought together numerous theatre groups, writers, directors and theatre lovers, creating a vibrant and inspiring environment.

The ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation is dedicated to promoting **culture** and **education**. As part of our commitment, we sponsored the event with €2,000.



Moldova.

## We financially supported expensive medical treatments

#### Corina Cîmpan

Corina Cimpan, an endocrinology resident, was diagnosed with a grade 4 brain tumor and neurofibromatosis.

Corina is a mother of two children aged 2 years and 4 months respectively.

The ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation contributed €1,000 to support Corina.

#### **Ionuţ Stavnic**

Ionuţ Stavnic is a 24-year-old young man from Suceava studying for his master's at the Cluj Napoca Faculty of Art and Design, who was recently diagnosed with colon cancer, having metastases in the lungs and liver.

To complete the treatment, a total of €36,000 is needed, of which €4,000 was covered by the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation.

#### We donated blood on World Blood Donor Day

Every year, on June 14th, the global community celebrates **World Blood Donor Day.** It is a special occasion to recognize and celebrate the generosity and courage of blood donors worldwide. The ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation volunteers mobilize in this regard every year, some even more often. In addition to donating, we also motivate those around us to join this campaign, promoting the message and the act itself.



Through their **dedication and altruism** this year, **19 volunteers** of our foundation saved almost **60 lives.**Because many people don't know exactly what the donation process entails, one of the foundation's volunteers made a <u>video</u> explaining the steps. It presents the steps, starting with the main conditions that any donor must meet and ending with the reasons why **we encourage you to become a donor**, too.







We organized a Charity Christmas Concert to equip ISU Suceava with CPR manikins.

On December 8th, the St. John Nepomuk Catholic Church in Suceava was host to an evening of story-telling wrapped in a symphony of generosity.

This concert had a charitable purpose, namely the collection of funds for the purchase of three sets of CPR manikins for three subunits of ISU Suceava.

On top of that, ISU Suceava is starting the "Lifesaver for Passion" program, which gathers 1000 volunteers from Suceava who support medical staff in saving lives. These volunteers will not only assist in emergency situations, but will also play a crucial educational role. They will be involved in schools as part of the "Scoala Altfel" Week and leadership classes, giving students the opportunity to learn and practice first aid.


