




# MODERNIZATION PROJECT

## “ION CARP FLUIERICI” AUDITORIUM „CIPRIAN PORUMBESCU” ART COLLEGE, SUCEAVA

After more than two decades since the last renovations, the “Ion Carp FluiERICI” Auditorium at the Ciprian Porumbescu Art College in Suceava was in a state of advanced wear and tear. Old seats, noisy flooring, and inadequate lighting were just a few of the issues affecting the quality of artistic performances. At the end of 2024, the ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation took the initiative to modernize this space dedicated to the cultural development of young people in the Suceava community.

Since December 2024, we have made the vision of a modern auditorium a reality. Now, this space allows art to be appreciated at its full potential.





## UPGRADES MADE TO THE AUDITORIUM:

- Wall repair and interior finishes;
- Flooring and seating replacement;
- Stage curtains and lighting installation;
- Doors and windows replacement;
- Volumetric ceiling construction;
- Speakers and acoustic panels installation;
- Electrical and heating systems modernization;
- Air treatment unit installation;
- Screen and video projector replacement.

# EDUCATION

---

In 2025, we focused our efforts on educational projects designed to support the healthy development of young people in Suceava County and provide them with innovative learning opportunities. Through our ongoing initiatives, we aim to give everyone equal access to quality education and a real chance at a successful future, with concrete career opportunities within the local community.

01

We sponsored a Romanian team's participation in the "EXPO Science Belgium" International Competition, which brings together young science enthusiasts from across Europe.  
**Sponsorship value ≈ 2.450EUR**



02

We supported four series of "Integrating Children with Special Educational Needs in Schools" courses, organized by the George Tofan Teacher Training Center in Suceava, for 200 teachers from Suceava County.  
**Amount allocated ≈ 39,010EUR**



The ASSIST Humanitarian Foundation funds a teacher training program in Suceava County to support the integration of students with special educational needs (SEN) into the pre-university education system. The training program, "Integrating Children with SEN in Schools", is accredited under the Ministry of Education Order no. 7890/28.12.2024 and has a total duration of 60 hours.

We continued the Educational Caravan project "Health in Motion" with practical activities dedicated to children and teenagers from the "Nicanor Moroşan" Technological High School in Pârteştii de Jos.

The "Health in Motion" Educational Caravan is a health education project for children and adolescents from rural areas. It brings information directly to communities with limited access to medical and educational resources. The program combines interactive sessions, practical demonstrations, and hands-on activities to cover essential topics such as hygiene, oral health, prevention, first aid, safety, nutrition, and physical activity.

The project is designed as an age-appropriate educational experience that combines clear information with non-formal learning methods. By involving specialists from various fields, the caravan helps develop healthy habits and personal responsibility and improves health education in vulnerable communities.


